### 1.b Topsail Lift Station - Maintenance Approval

Following an inspection assessment, significant maintenance is required to the pump components at the Topsail Lift Station. The maintenance details and quote was discussed.

A few key reminders;

- Yard waste curbside collection commences November 7 for 4 weeks.

- Temporary speed humps will be removed for winter season over the comings days.
- RWS have provided minutes to the last meeting regarding regional water agreements. The action is currently with RWS to revised agreements and meet with customers regarding changes.
