STEP OR RIDE BACK IN TIME

The T'Railway is a true gem of Conception Bay South (CBS). This scenic route follows the former railbed along the coast, through wooded areas and right into the heart of downtown.

Built in the 1880s, the Newfoundland Railway stretched coast to coast carrying freight and passengers into the later half of the 20th century. The T'Railway will take you back in time as you explore the cultural heritage of the community. Soak up the stunning views and if it's the season, keep your eye out for whales and icebergs. The T'Railway has it all!
