In the early 1970s, equipped with a backhoe and single-axle dump truck, Eric Taylor ventured into the construction industry, doing odd jobs on evenings and weekends. By 1979, he officially incorporated Eric Taylor Ltd., first only servicing the immediate area of Foxtrap, and in time expanding, taking various government contracts in the region. The business continued to grow from there.

In 2012, Eric's daughter Roxanne and her husband Glen purchased the company. Since then, Eric's grandsons Tim and Coady have been at the helm, running the business for their parents. With a

shared vision, the brothers have been leading the charge together and steering the company towards new heights.

The scope of the business' services has evolved over the years. From early projects involving grading roads and supplying winter sand, to becoming a prominent water and sewer contractor, the business has surely diversified its offerings. Today, the business also takes on civil and concrete projects. They have acquired highly specialized equipment, some of it being the first of its kind in Atlantic Canada, contributing significantly to their competitive advantage.

From its humble beginnings with 2-3 employees, Eric Taylor Ltd. has grown into one of the largest construction companies in Conception Bay South, currently with a team of 32. Each of these employees are from Conception Bay South, demonstrating the company's commitment to the community. Many of their projects happen within the town, too. This past October, Eric Taylor Ltd. facilitated the Peacekeepers Way culvert replacement - their highest profile project to date.
